

MAYNE ISLAND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 103

A bylaw for levying taxes on the land and improvements within the Mayne Island Improvement District, hereinafter referred to as the "Improvement District", for fire protection purposes.

The Trustees of Mayne Island Improvement District in open meeting assembled ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sum of Five Hundred and Ninety Two Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Two Dollars (\$592,842) is required by the Improvement District for fire protection in the year of 2011.
2. A tax at a rate determined to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum is hereby levied for the year 2011 on all land and improvements as defined in the School Act, within the Improvement District in accordance with Section 756 of the Local Government Act.
3. The said taxes shall be due and payable as provided in the Taxation (Rural Area) Act and if delinquent shall bear interest at the rate set out under the Taxation (Rural Area) Act until paid or recovered.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Protection Taxation Bylaw 2011".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 23rd day of September, 2010.


