

MAYNE ISLAND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
BYLAW NO. 112

A bylaw to amend Mayne Island Improvement District Bylaw No. 46 which provides for the establishment and operation of a fire department on Mayne Island.

The Trustees of Mayne Island Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Mayne Island Improvement District Bylaw No. 46 is hereby amended by deleting section 6 of the bylaw in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
 6. In addition to any agreement to provide services beyond the boundary of the improvement district, at the direction of the Fire Chief, the fire department may respond to requests from authorized agencies for assistance beyond the boundary of the improvement district.

2. Bylaw No. 46 is further amended to include the following sections:
 - 6.1. The authority to respond to requests for assistance may only be exercised in relation to the following services:
 - (a) fire suppression
 - (b) rescue
 - (c) assistance where there is a risk of immediate harm to persons or property including:
 - (i) medical emergencies
 - (ii) hazardous material incidents
 - (iii) motor vehicle incidents.

 - 6.2: The authority in Section 6 may only be exercised if a local government does not provide the same service in that area.

 - 6.3: The authority in Section 6 may only be exercised to the extent that the ability of the fire department to respond to an incident that occurs within its boundary will not be compromised by responding to a request outside the boundary.


3. This bylaw may be cited as the "Fire Department Establishment and Operations Amendment Bylaw No. 112, September 16, 2011".


