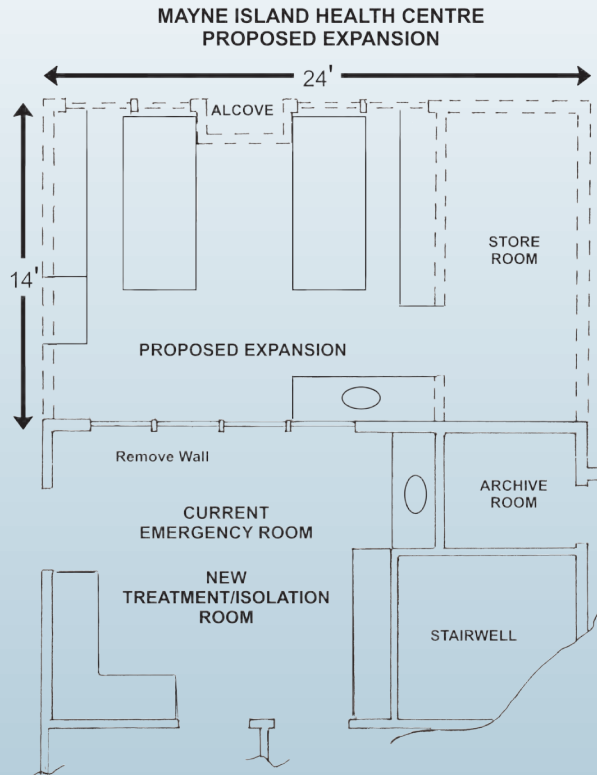

what we HAVE

AN OVERCROWDED EMERGENCY AREA that is NO LONGER FUNCTIONAL

Our current Emergency Room has become a multi-purpose space used for a number of services that are not emergent. This has resulted in the room being crowded with equipment, furniture and supplies which make it difficult to work in and a challenge to clean.

what we NEED

A DEDICATED TREATMENT/ISOLATION ROOM

... designed to be used for minor procedures and with a dedicated isolation area to separate infectious patients from those in the waiting room and from patients receiving treatment in other areas. With the advent of antibiotic-resistant bacteria, it is necessary that this area remain uncluttered. It is imperative that emergency treatment and isolation rooms be easily cleaned and disinfected.

All storage space needs to be enclosed.

what we NEED

ADEQUATE STORAGE SPACE

Increased medical personnel means increasing amounts of supplies and equipment, all of which must be stored away from possible sources of contamination by infectious agents, i.e., behind closed doors. Open shelving will need to be upgraded in the Emergency Treatment Area and in the Treatment/Isolation Room.
