## **Vehicles Policy - Standard Vehicle Markings**

### **POLICY STATEMENT**

All front-line apparatus and support fire department vehicles shall have standardized identifying marking noting that it is the property of the Mayne Island Fire Department.

All volunteer fire fighters shall be offered license plate markings showing that they are an active member of Mayne Island Fire Rescue.

### **Apparatus and Support Vehicles**

- All vehicle markings shall comply with NF PA standards where applicable.
- New apparatus when purchased shall have appropriate markings depicting Mayne Island Fire Rescue included in any Request for Proposal.
- Support apparatus when purchased shall have appropriate markings depicting Mayne Island Fire Rescue installed during installation of any emergency lighting packages.

### **Volunteer Fire Fighters – Private Vehicles**

- Volunteer fire fighters after completion of their probation shall be issued a license plate decal for the vehicle for which the fire fighter is registered as the owner or principal operator.
- A second license plate decal may be issued at the discretion of the Fire Chief or his designate.
- Volunteer fire fighters upon retirement or discharge shall remove their license plate decal from their vehicle and return the decal or plate to the MI Fire Department.
- With the exception of “Lifetime Members” no retired member shall exhibit on his private vehicle the license plate decal depicting them as an active member of Mayne Island Fire Rescue.
- Volunteers may decline to accept and/or display license plate decals.
