under the *Water Act* by Letters Patent issued on April 20, 1964:

And whereas it is provided in section 825 of the *Municipal Act* that the Lieutenant Governor in Council may at any time amend the Letters Patent of any improvement district in any respect:

WHEREAS the Mayne Island Improvement District is an improvement district incorporated

Letters Patent issued

And whereas the trustees of the Mayne Island Improvement District have requested that the Letters Patent be amended to include the operation and maintenance of the Mayne Island Health Centre:

Now know ye that by these presents We do order and proclaim that on, from and after the date of these supplementary Letters Patent the maintenance and operation of the Mayne Island Health Centre and all matters incidental thereto shall be added as an object to the Letters Patent of the Mayne Island Improvement District:

And that the Letters Patent dated April 20, 1964, shall be amended by striking out section 3 in its entirety and substituting the following therefor:

“3. The objects of the Mayne Island Improvement District shall be the provision of fire protection, the provision of garbage collection and disposal, the operation of the Mayne Island Health Centre and the acquisition, maintenance and operation of works, buildings and equipment for these purposes and all matters incidental thereto.”

And that the Letters Patent of the Mayne Island Improvement District be deemed to be amended so as to conform to the premises as and from the date of these supplementary Letters Patent.

In testimony whereof, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our said Province to be hereunto affixed.

Witness, the Honourable Robert G. Rogers, Lieutenant Governor of Our said Province of British Columbia, in Our City of Victoria, in Our said Province, this fifteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and in the thirty-second year of Our Reign.
